

Instructions for LaTeX Formatting of Articles for ATMP International Press – May 2005

1. Download the files *atmp.cls* and *atmp_sample_tex_file.tex* from the Submissions page at <http://www.intlpress.com/ATMP/>
2. Place both files together in the same directory. You'll probably also want to include the file with the original text of your article, in .tex format or otherwise.
3. Rename *atmp_sample_tex_file.tex* – this file will end up as your article formatted for ATMP, so name it appropriately.
4. Open the newly named file in your .tex editor of choice. This file is the template into which you will be pasting the text and meta-information for your article.
5. Replace the fields marked with angle-brackets with the appropriate information from your paper. For example, “<author names>” would become “A. U. Thor and I. P. Ress”. Be SURE not to leave the angle brackets in place. [Don't worry about including the page numbers for the journal, IP will take care of that after the article is submitted.]
6. Compile your document with LaTeX, and preview it with whatever DVI viewer you use. Make sure it looks appropriate, that the in-paper references properly refer to the bibliography items. [If this is not working correctly and you cannot trouble-shoot yourself, please email a description of your problem to atmp@intlpress.com (if possible, attach the saved .tex file for your article to speed trouble-shooting).]
7. Make any necessary changes to the .tex file & recompile.
8. Upload the new version of the article to arXiv.org, and then submit the article by emailing it, along with the arXiv reference #, to: atmp@intlpress.com.
